Ten tips to protect your luggage



We've all heard of horror stories concerning travellers who, having left their luggage unattended, have been trapped by non scrupulous crooks who explored their naivety.

These stories don't happen only to others. So it's of the utmost importance to always protect your luggage.

Here are ten suggestions to better protect your luggage against the unforeseen whereabouts.

- 1** – If decorating one's suitcase with labels confirms your status as a « globe-trotter », it's not that prudent and it can create confusion as to your final destination.
- 2** – Clearly indicate your contact details on the luggage labels. At the time of departure, ensure that these labels will accompany you all the way to your destination.
- 3** – choose funny identifications, therefore easy to recognize.
- 4** – Add colour stickers, ribbons, old scarves to make your luggage even more distinctive.
- 5** – On a large sheet, clearly write your contact details and place this document inside your suitcase in such a way that one can see it upon opening., In case of loss, it will facilitate searches a great deal.

- 6** – Carefully wrap the fragile objects and place them between two garments or, in the case of a bottle of wine, fit the top and the bottom of this last into a pair of sandals.
- 7** – Of course, never accept to transport whatever item it may be for someone else, even if you know the person. Do we really know a person?
- 8** – Never leave your luggage unattended. Things may be put inside, your luggage could disappear or even be destroyed if they should be considered as suspects.
- 9** – Along the same lines, should you notice an unattended luggage for a certain time, inform the security.
